Pursuant to Art. 17 clause 1 of the Regulations (eu) no 596/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 on market abuse (market abuse regulation) and repealing Directive 2003/6/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council and Commission Directives 2003/124/EC, 2003/125/EC and 2004/72/EC (hereinafter “MAR Regulations”), The Management Board of Orange Polska S.A. (“Orange Polska”) hereby informs about the conclusion of the agreement with P4 Sp. z o.o.

Orange Polska extends national roaming contract with Play securing PLN 300 million revenues until 2025

On 7 June 2021 Orange Polska and P4 (operator of Play network) have signed extension of national roaming agreement (the current agreement expires in June 2021). The co-operation will be continued in the current take-or-pay scheme, which guarantees additional minimum revenue for Orange Polska of PLN 300 million in total for 2021-2025. The agreement concerns relatively limited volume of traffic compared to that generated by Orange Polska’s own customers and has built-in controls in order to secure adequate quality of services.

Moreover, the Company informs that on 14 May 2021, pursuant to article 17 clause 4 of the MAR Regulations, it decided to delay disclosure to the public of the inside information. In the view of the Management Board the progress of negotiations regarding the conclusion of the agreement between Orange Polska and P4, constituted from 14 May 2021 inside information within the meaning of Article 7 of the MAR Regulations. However, having in mind that immediate disclosure to the public of this information could prejudice the legitimate interests of Orange Polska.
